Burning Information

Burning is allowed only on **Monday and Wednesday from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM and Saturday from 7:00 AM to 11:00 AM**. Burning must be within a burn container and cannot be within ten feet of any building, property line or street line. Only paper products are to be burned.

Weeds and Grass

Weeds and/or grass must **NOT** be taller than twelve (12) inches in height on any property. Also, **NO** weeds and/or grass should be allowed to grow between the public sidewalks on your property.



Yard Sale/Garage Sale Signs Proposed Revisions Coming
