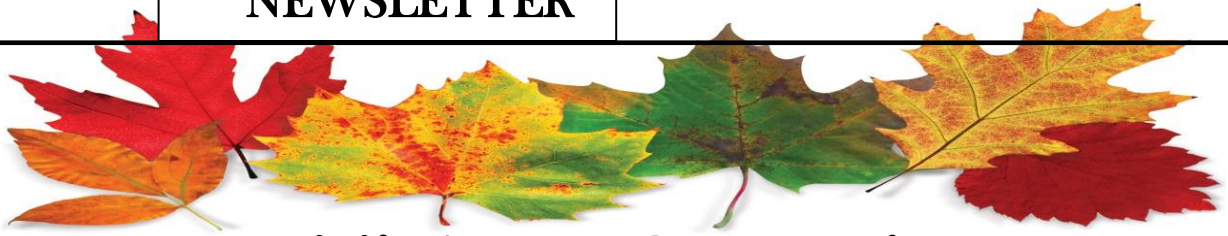

We are accepting vendors and food stands. Limited spaces are available. Our purpose is to aesthetically improve the town of Middleburg.

Borough Mayor's Message

I appreciate this opportunity to introduce myself to those of you who may not know me, and also to give you an idea of the responsibilities of the Mayor of Middleburg Borough.

I have been a resident of the borough for more than 20 years. Following appointment by Borough Council on Jan. 30, I was sworn in the beginning of February and began my role as Mayor. My term will continue until the first Monday in January 2020.

In my official capacity, I attend borough meetings each month and in the event of a tie or split vote, I will be called upon to cast the deciding vote. I serve as the liaison between the Borough Council and the Police Department, having been given full charge and control of the police chief and officers. Because this is extremely important, I hold monthly meetings with Chief Jordan and Officers Shaffer and Thomas, and other times throughout the month as needed. I am pleased to be working with such a dedicated police force.

My main objective as Mayor is to work with Borough Council, the Police Department and YOU as the residents of this community. Together we can continue to make changes and improvements that benefit the residents, the business owners, those who work here and those who visit.

Changes take time, energy and dedication. I ask that you join me by committing time to something in this community. Whether it is volunteering to serve in any of our churches, Mid-West School District, Reliance Hose Company and the Ladies Auxiliary, the Middleburg Revitalization Committee, Middleburg Community Library, scout troops or any number of annual events, we can all work together to bring positive change.

Borough Ordinance Information

NEW PROPERTY MAINTENANCE - The Borough adopted the 2018 Edition of the International Property Maintenance Code, which provides for issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor; provides for penalties and fines for a violation of the code; and repeals prior Borough Ordinance No. 327. You may review the new ordinance at the Borough's website or by stopping by the Borough office during normal business hours.

NEW YARD SALE ORDINANCE - The Borough adopted a Yard Sale Ordinance, which is intended to ensure that any yard sales conducted or advertised in the Borough by: 1) preserving the character and value of the neighborhoods in which the yard sales may occur; 2) preventing prolonged or perpetual yard sales; 3) preventing nuisances; and 4) complying with existing Borough ordinances, codes and regulations, including the zoning ordinance.

You may access the Borough Code of Ordinances at the Borough's website (www.middleburgborough.com) or you may obtain a copy of any ordinance at the Borough office during normal business office hours. A copy fee of 25 cents per page will be charged if a copy is requested.

If you wish to file a Zoning or Ordinance Complaint with the Zoning Officer, you may do so by coming to or contacting the Borough Office. Please understand no complaint will be acted upon without a compliant form being completed. A copy of the compliant form can be found on the borough's website.

Snowfall & Weather Emergency Parking:

Borough Ordinance 2016-332: During and following any snowfall or weather emergency, it shall be unlawful for anyone to park a motor vehicle and/or place any property or objects on or along any street or alley in the Borough. A snowfall or weather emergency shall exist when a winter weather advisory or warning is issued by the National Weather Service of Snyder County and for a period of eight (8) hours after the advisory or warning has expired.
