Municipal Authority customers can also find a payment link on the Borough’s website, which allows for online payment of water and/or sewer bills via your credit/debit card.

## Borough Code Regulations

**Burning** is allowed only on Monday and Wednesday from 7 AM to 7 PM and on Saturday from 7 AM to 11 AM. Burning must be within a burning container and cannot be within ten (10) feet of any building, property line or street edge. **Only paper products may be burnt.**

**Weeds and/or Grass** may not be taller than twelve (12) inches in height on any property. Also, **NO** weeds and/or grass should be allowed to grow between the public sidewalks on any property.

**Animal Defecation** is restricted from occurring on any public or private property, other than your own private property. **If** your pet defecates on public or private property, you are responsible to remove and dispose of the feces in a sanitary method. **Reminder** this includes the new Borough Dog Park area, where bags and containers are provided for your use.

**Motor Vehicles**, which are inoperative and/or unlicensed shall not be parked, kept or stored in the open on any property and vehicles shall not at any time be in a state of major disassembly, disrepair or in the process of being stripped or dismantled.

**Garbage and/or Rubbish** accumulation on any property is prohibited. Disposal of all garbage and/or rubbish must be provided for in a clean and sanitary manner by using approved containers. Disposal of garbage and/or rubbish is the responsibility of the property owner.

**Swimming Pools** capable of containing water more than twenty-four (24) inches in depth shall be completely surrounded by a fence or barrier not less than forty-eight (48) in height above the finished ground leveled measured on the side of the barrier away from the pool.

**If you wish to file a complaint regarding any Borough Code Regulation, you may do so by coming to or contacting the Borough Office. NO complaint will be acted upon if you are not willing to complete a complaint form or provide your contact information when contacting the Borough Office. A copy of the complaint form is also available on the Borough’s website.**
