## ORDINANCE NO. 2022-361

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLEBURG, SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO FIX THE GENERAL TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 AT 27 MILLS, TO FIX THE STREET LIGHT TAX AT 2.5 MILLS, AND TO FIX THE ROAD TAX AT 2.5 MILLS.

AND NOW, pursuant to Section 1310.1 of the Pennsylvania Borough Code, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Middleburg, Snyder County, Pennsylvania:

Section 1: That a tax be, and the same is hereby, levied on all real property within the Borough of Middleburg subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 2023 as follows:

- a) Tax rate for general Borough purposes shall increase One (1) mill and shall be the sum of Twenty-Seven (27) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.
- b) Tax rate for street lighting purposes shall remain unchanged and shall be the sum of Two and Five Tenths mills (2.5) on each dollar of assessed valuation.
- c) Tax rate for special road fund purposes shall increase One (1) mill and shall be the sum of Two and Five Tenths (2.5) of a mill on each dollar of assessed valuation.

Section 2: That any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with this ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
