

**MIDDLEBURG BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE NO. 2025-375**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLEBURG, SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER FIFTEEN, PART FOUR HUNDRED AND TWO (§ 15-402) OF THE MIDDLEBURG BOROUGH CODE TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON THE WEST SIDE OF NORTH CHARLES AVENUE FROM WEST OAK AVENUE TO PINE STREET**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Borough of Middleburg, pursuant to its authority under the Pennsylvania Borough Code, amends Chapter Fifteen, Part Four Hundred and Two (§ 15-402), "Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations" to prohibit parking on certain streets within the Borough of Middleburg to promote the health, safety and welfare of the residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Borough of Middleburg has proposed amending Chapter Fifteen, Part Four Hundred and Two, to prohibit parking on the west side of North Charles Avenue from West Oak Avenue to Pine Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Borough of Middleburg believes that this Ordinance will establish clear and specific requirements and prohibitions to protect the welfare of pedestrians and other persons seeking to use North Charles Avenue.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED**, by the Council of the Borough of Middleburg, Snyder County, Pennsylvania:

**§ 15-402. Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations.**

Parking shall be prohibited at all times in the following locations:

STREET	SIDE	Location
Church Street	East and West	South Main Street to Edmond Avenue
East Market Street	North	Cemetery Road to East Borough line
East Market Street	South	Stumps Run Bridge to East Borough line
Furnace Road	East and West	West side from West Market Street in a southerly direction 57 feet and also from Willow Avenue in a northerly direction 37 feet; and east side from West Market Street in a southerly direction 41 feet
Main Street	Both	Except in marked spaces*
Market Street	East	Main Street to East Willow Avenue, except in marked spaces*

Market Street	West	Main Street to Charles Avenue, except in marked spaces*
North Charles Avenue	West and East	West Market Street to West Oak Avenue
North Charles Avenue	West and East	West Oak Avenue to Pine Street
North Main	East and West	Market Street to north Borough line
Old School Road	East and West	Pine Street to West Oak Avenue, except in marked spaces*
Pine Street	North	From North Main Street westerly 30 feet, 15 feet on either side of Old School Road, and from 30 feet east of the intersection with North Charles Avenue to the intersection
Pine Street	South	From North Charles Avenue to North Main Street
Railroad Avenue	East and West	East Main Street to Wausau Road
South Charles Avenue	East and West	From West Market Street to West Willow Avenue
West Market Street	North	100 feet west
West Market Street	South	From the intersection with Furnace Road in a westerly direction 38 feet; and from the intersection with Furnace Road in an easterly direction 37 feet
Winey Avenue	East and West	Grand Street to Thomas Avenue

Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$50 and costs.

**Section 2: Saving Clause.** Nothing in this Part shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed, nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this part.

**Section 3: Severability.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Part is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Part. The Borough of Middleburg hereby declares that it would have passed this Part, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsection, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional.


**Section 4: Date of Effect.** This Part and the rules, regulations, provisions, requirements, orders and matters established and adopted hereby shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately from and after the date of its final passage and adoption in accordance with laws and regulations.

**Section 5: Repealer.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed only to the extent that they are in conflict herewith.


