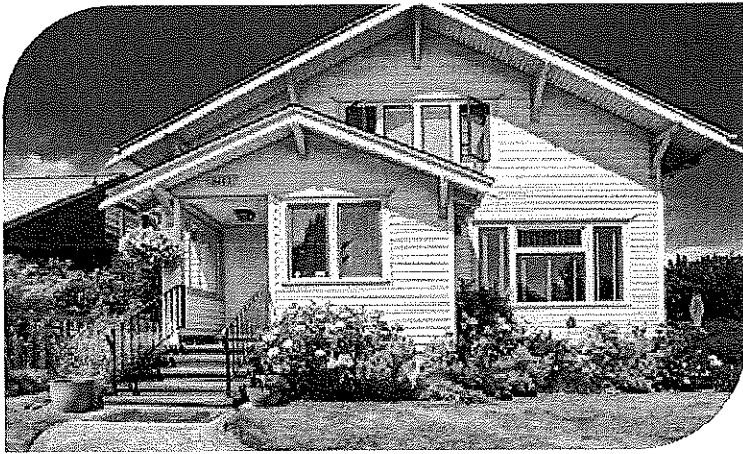


EMERGENCY RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

FOR UNION AND SNYDER COUNTY RENTERS



Union and Snyder counties received a combined \$5.6 million for emergency rental assistance.




Union-Snyder Community Action Agency (CAA) is now processing applications to distribute this emergency funding for eligible residents.

Union and Snyder counties are offering financial assistance to residents with unpaid rent or utility bills due to the impact of COVID-19.

Eligibility Requirements Include:

- Eligible expenses include rent, utility, and home energy costs.
- Eligible households include those with reduced income or financial hardships that were directly or indirectly related to COVID-19.
