Please note: West Nile has been detected in the Middleburg area by the Mosquito-Disease Control Team. They are keeping a very close eye on the area and have been treating breeding areas for mosquito larvae. They have since set multiple adult mosquito traps to get a better idea of virus activity in the area, as well as adult mosquito populations.

Even though there is a low risk of disease transmission, residents are encouraged to:

- Apply bug spray with at least 30% DEET
- Remove any standing water from your property (water standing for more than 4 days can breed mosquitoes that can carry WNV).
