LOCAL SERVICE TAX REMINDER
SELF-EMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS

Your local service tax payment must be paid in full, or the first quarterly payment must be submitted to the Middleburg Borough Office **NO LATER than April 30, 2021**. If you are filing exemption from the tax, please provide the Borough with the exemption form and necessary paperwork.

If a tax payment or an exemption form is not received in the Middleburg Borough Office by April 30, 2021 penalties and interest will be charged. If you have questions, please contact the Borough Office at 570-837-2533, during office hours.

WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS



Penn VEST awarded the Middleburg Municipal Authority a \$4,586,200.00 loan along with a grant amount of \$555,024.00 for Water System Improvements. The project will replace old cast iron and asbestos cement pipe with approximately 10,330 feet of 8-inch ductile iron pipe in the borough. In addition, an old reservoir tank will be replaced with a new 290,000-gallon concrete water storage tank, and a new 163,000-gallon steel standpipe tank will be installed to enhance water pressure.



Shaffer Landscapes, Inc. has announced that starting April 1, 2021 their compost recycling facility will be going to an annual pay fee basis for use of facility. After 30 years of free access and continued increase in costs to run, SLI will be charging a \$15.00 annual fee for residential usage. Commercial customers such as landscapers & tree companies will be charged \$350.00 per year. Industrial customer's fees will be by quote only.

Benefits to the residential clients will be a 25% discount to all mulch & related products created from composting. Cards will be provided when signing up (cards must be present on every visit). A \$5.00 daily fee for residents will be administered for customers who do not have cards present or making a one-time visit. Rules and regulations will be posted at a garden center check station. The Borough Zoning Officer would like to share the following sections of the Borough Code listed below. To view the entire Borough Code please visit www.middleburgborough.com or feel free to contact the Borough Office at 570-837-2533.

BURNING is allowed on Monday and Wednesday from 7 AM to 7 PM and on Saturday from 7 AM to 11 AM. Please be sure to burn within a burning container and not within ten (10) feet of any building, property line or street edge. Only paper products should be burnt.

ANIMAL DEFECACTION should not occur on any public or private property, other than pet owner's private property. If your pet defecates on public or private property, owner is responsible to remove and dispose of the feces in a sanitary method. *Reminder this includes the new Borough Dog Park area, where bags and containers are provided for your use.*

YARD SALE(S) - Only six-yard sales may be held per year on the same property. No yard sale may continue for more than four consecutive days. Yard sale signs shall be not be greater than six square feet. A yard sale sign must include the dates of the yard sale and the address where the yard sale is occurring. Yard sale signs may be posted seven days before the beginning of the yard sale and must be removed no later than the day after the end of the yard sale.
